Each person may submit only one paper and present only one paper. However, each person is allowed to be a co-author of several papers submitted to the conference.

Financial support will be availed to young African researchers who wish to present papers during the conference. The allocation of the grants will be on a competitive basis and applications will be evaluated by a review committee. The grants will cover travel and accommodation expenses.
